Request for voluntary suspension (continued)

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Cape Lambert Resources Limited (“Cape Lambert” or the “Company”) requests to extend the current voluntary suspension in respect of its ordinary shares (ASX: **CFE**), effective immediately.

The voluntary suspension is requested pending an announcement by the Company regarding the Company’s Kipushi Cobalt-Copper Tailings Project (**Kipushi Project**) located in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (**DRC**). The Company notes that Tony Sage, Cape Lambert Executive Chairman, has flown to Africa to finalise discussions on the Kipushi Project matter. The Company also wishes to update shareholders that assay results from samples taken from the Kipushi Project continue to be analysed with results expected in the near future.

The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until the earlier of the release of the announcement, or prior to the commencement of trading on Wednesday 13 February 2019.

Cape Lambert is not aware of any reason why the suspension from quotation should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the suspension.
